The National Cannabis Prevention and Information Centre (NCPIC) was established in response to community concerns about cannabis use. Its mission is to reduce the use of cannabis in Australia by preventing uptake and providing the community with evidence-based information and interventions. An important element of this involves disseminating resources to service providers working in areas such as alcohol and other drugs, healthcare and youth work.
